
## **Shapes in Worship**



- 1. Draw on to this photograph all the lines of symmetry.
- Name all the geometric shapes you can see, then code them so that you can add to the diagram the numbers matched to the shapes, e.g. 1- rectangle; 2 square; 3 triangle; 4 kite; 5 pentagon; 6 hexagon; 7 heptagon; 8 octagon; 9 circle; 10 crescent; 11 ellipse; 12 oval; 13 asteroid; 14 cylinder.
- 3. The medieval cathedrals and monasteries used a select range of shapes because they reminded people of principles and teachings from their faith. Investigate the floor plans and images of these cathedrals to look for the 2 dimension and 3 dimensional regular shapes that research suggests are used for spiritual reasons, e.g. 12 pillars to represent the 12 tribes/disciples, triangle the trinity.
